

LEAF COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Program begins mid-October and runs through December (weather permitting).

- Pile the leaves parallel to the roadway. Long narrow piles are better than a large deep pile.
- Leaves only. No grass clippings, ornamental grasses, perennials or other flower bed debris.
- Piles need to be clean of debris such as branches, trash, dirt clods, construction materials, metal, nails, wire or anything that can damage equipment.
- Do not put piles in the street to avoid storm drain blockages or dangerous roadway situations.
- Do not cover culvert inlets or storm basins.
- Do not put leaves in cul-de-sac islands.

To ensure all residents and workers safety, please use caution while driving around leaf collection crews.
